The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting in the Township Municipal Building on Wednesday April 28, 2010. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

**Approval of Minutes**

A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve the meeting minutes for April 14, 2010. Mr. Kucsan abstained. The motion carried.

**Supervisors' Comments**

Mr. Boucher commented that the fire company has their new truck and it will be on display in the parking lot during our next meeting on May 12<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Johnson had no comments.

Mr. Nagle, along with Mr. Kucsan, attended the CRPC meeting on Monday night. There was an executive session to discuss salaries. Lower Nazareth Township was out voted 2-1. Mr. Nagle and Mr. Kucsan were very unhappy with the vote. Hanover Township has always been a "spender", Bath was frugal and Lower Nazareth brought balance. Lately, Hanover and Bath have "teamed up" against Lower Nazareth Township.

## **Manager's Report**

**2010 Animal Contract** – Mr. Tenges reported that he doesn't like the agreement however believes it is in the best interest of the township to do enter into this agreement. After a brief discussion a motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve the 2010 Animal Service Contract; allowing police or an animal control officer to take dogs and/or cats to the Center. Mr. Kucsan abstained. The motion carried.

**2010 PSATS Convention** – Mr. Tenges attended a preventative roadway maintenance program while attending the conference. The chip seal process involves a layer of oil, a layer of fiberglass fibers, followed by another layer of oil and lastly stone. Mr. Tenges believes we have 3 miles of road that could benefit from this process. The company demonstrated the process on the parking lot at the Hershey Lodge. Mr. Tenges said he would check the condition of the parking lot later this summer to see how it holds up to weathering.

**TCC Meeting** – Mr. Tenges continues to attend TCC meetings and work on developing an RFP. They hope to have the RFP for a tax collector ready within two weeks. Northampton County reportedly has the most in depth RFP. Hopefully they can make a decision on the tax collector by the end of August. Tax collection would begin in January 2012.

**Recycling** – Letters informing residents of the new recycling ordinance and vouchers regarding the distribution of recycling containers were mailed this week. Distribution will take place one Saturday in May and one in June. The staff will assist with the distribution. We have created an internal FAQ list to help staff respond to inquiries about the ordinance and container pick-up.

**Lion's Club benches** – Mr. Kucsan has approached the Lion's Club about installing benches by the trees in the park. The bench would be made of low-maintenance trex boards and would be concreted in the ground. Mr. Kucsan would like the Lion's Club to donate one bench annually and possibly in other parks like Hahn's Meadow.

**Surrey Glen** – Mr. Tenges reported that the Surrey Glen sign and fence have been vandalized; township crew will do their best to fix the damage.

**Meeting Room / Trophy Clean-up** – Mr. Tenges reported that each organization was made to organize their trophies. Some are displayed and the rest were placed in storage. Continual maintenance will be conducted to keep the cases neat and organized.

## **Engineer's Report**

**Colt's Ridge – Letter of Credit Reduction** - Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter dated April 23, 2010. He recommended reducing the letter of credit from its current balance of \$187,888.33 to \$175,709.13.

A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to reduce the letter of credit. The motion carried.

## **Solicitor's Report**

**DeBonis Litigation** – Solicitor Asteak reported that the DeBonis litigation is heating up. The DeBonis' family states that the pipe is on their neighbor's property. Solicitor Asteak asked the Board to authorize Mr. Kortze to go to the property and investigate. A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Kucsan to authorize Mr. Kortze to investigate which the property the pipe is on. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve the bills dated April 28, 2010. The motion carried.


**Courtesy of the Floor**
