LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES SEPTEMBER 25, 2013

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting in the Township Municipal Building on Wednesday September 25, 2013. The Vice Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve the meeting minutes for September 11, 2013. The motion carried.

Subdivision and Land Development

There were no items to discuss under Subdivision and Land Development

Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Green and Mr. Boucher had no comments.

Mr. Pennington attended the September 23rd Colonial Regional Police Meeting (CRPC) where a 2014 preliminary budget was presented. Two versions were proposed with the first reflecting a 3% increase and keeping the current number of policeman on staff. The second proposal had an increase of 4.5% and included the hiring of a new police officer.

Manager's Report

Mr. Tenges reported that the 2012 Financial Statements are now complete.

Mr. Tenges also stated that at our next Board of Supervisors meeting being held on October 9th, that Borton-Lawson will be making a presentation for the reconstruction of the bridge on Georgetown Road. They will be explaining the repairs and the road closure while the bridge is being replaced.

Lastly Mr. Tenges wanted to report on the progress of the new building, stating that a sign has been installed and a new flagpole has been erected.

Engineer's Report

There were no items to discuss under Engineer's Report.

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Solicitor's Report

Attorney Asteak reported that the Brown Daub Conditional Use Opinion is completed. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and seconded by Mr. Green to authorize the Chairman to sign off once the Manager has reviewed the opinion and is in favor of it. The motion carried.

Attorney Asteak also reported that the tax exemption for 623 Municipal Drive has been approved for all but 1,000 square feet of office space that is currently being leased out which is taxable.

Attorney Asteak finished by stating that he has completed a draft ordinance for dealing with abandoned properties.

Old Business

There were no items to discuss under Old Business.

New Business

There were no items to discuss under New Business.

Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Green to approve payment of the bills dated September 25, 2013. The motion carried.

Courtesy of the Floor

Thomas Fiorni, 5000 Hanoverville Rd: Mr. Fiorni stated that the retention pond on the North East corner of Flora Lane is an eyesore and not being properly maintained. Mr. Tenges stated that they were already aware of this problem and had been in contact with the owner and that they have started to deal with the problem. Mr. Kortze also stated that they have had problems with sink holes around the pond and that was one of the reasons why it has not been maintained properly.

Mr. Fiorni also wanted to make it known that C&S Warehouse was responsible for an increase of truck traffic on roads that they are not allowed to travel on and that the beeping that occurs whenever they back up is nonstop and occurs all night long. Mr. Tenges stated that they have been in contact with C&S to make sure they disseminate strict rules for which roads the trucks are allowed to travel on. Mr. Pennington also stated that he would address the traveling on restricted roads at the next Police Commissioners meeting.

Adjournment

Before a motion for adjournment was made Mr. Pennington stated that an Executive Session would take place after the meeting to discuss a legal issue. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Green to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 6:50pm.
