Agenda Amendment and Approval

Subdivision and Land Development

<u>Popeye's / Valvoline Final Land Development – Resolution #LNT-16-25</u> – Julie Von Spreckelsen, Esq. attended on behalf of the applicant. She explained that they were looking for amended final land development approval. Lot "A" is where Popeye's will be located. Originally Lot "B" was where Take 5, an oil change and auto repair business was going to be located. The end user has changed and now will be Valvoline. She indicated it is the same use as Take 5 and Valvoline are direct competitors. The site plan has changes so an amended final land development plan is required. They are requesting one waiver: simultaneous review of a preliminary/final land development.

The applicant reviewed changes in plan with side-by-side plan of the original Take 5 and the new proposed Valvoline plans.

<u>DelSerro Sewer Capacity Request</u> – Solicitor Asteak noted that the Board is inclined to sell Mr. DelSerro sewer for the 202 lots subdivision: subject to negotiation. M. Boucher made a motion to sell sewer capacity, subject to negotiations. A. Templeton seconded. Motion passed (4-0)

Solicitor's Report

<u>Kay Builders / Trio Fields</u> – Solicitor Asteak reported that he has submitted the resolutions adopted at our last meeting. He has spoken to women at bank and sent the resolutions by FedEx. We are now awaiting deposit of funds to our escrow account.

<u>Hahn's Meadow Septic System Easement Agreement</u> – The agreement is between Lower Nazareth Township and 179 Partners, LLC. The two have adjoining properties with a portion of the septic system on the 179 Partners property encroaches upon a portion of the Township property. The agreement grants an easement for the septic system encroachment and details responsibility of the grantee (179 Partners, LLC).

J. Coyle noted that property corners are to be installed shortly. M. Boucher made a motion to authorize execution of the agreement. A. Templeton seconded. Motion passed (4-0).

Engineer's Report

<u>Trio Fields Phase VII – Letter of Credit Reduction</u> – J. Coyle reviewed his April 2nd letter. M. Boucher made a motion to approve the reduction in security. S. Brown seconded. Motion passed (4-0).
