The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a public meeting on Wednesday, August 27, 2025, Chairman Pennington called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Agenda Amendment and Approval

M. Boucher made a motion to approve the agenda. A. Templeton seconded. Motion passed (5-0).

Approval of Minutes

The meeting minutes of August 13th were submitted for review and approval. S. Brown made a motion to approve the minutes. N. Teague seconded. A. Templeton abstained. Motion passed (4-0).

Reports

The Financial Report for July was presented and available on the website.

Supervisor's Comments

Open Space Preservation – S. Brown had nothing new to report.

<u>Parks and Recreation</u> – A. Templeton reported that the Rec Committee met earlier today. She reminded everyone that Dog's Day Out is September 13th.

<u>Library News</u> – N. Teague reported that Touch a Truck is October 4th 10am-4pm. She noted that the proposed budget for 2026 9.5% increase 9.5% looks higher than really it is. The increase includes \$6,000 for lawn maintenance. The increase is closer to 3% if our public works crew continues to help with groundskeeping. She stated that fundraising has been increasing and noted that L. Stauffer has been assisting the library with this.

<u>CRPC</u> – M. Boucher attended the monthly meeting on Monday. J. Pennington reported that a preliminary budget presented.

Subdivision & Land Development

Northwood Preliminary Land Development & Waiver Requests – Present for the application: Laura Eberly, P.E. of Reuther + Bowen Engineering; Steven Selvaggio, Applicant; Matthew Potts of Goudsouzian and Associates.

- J. Coyle reviewed his letter with comments on the project and the applicant's waiver requests. He noted the narrowness of roadway and the Planning Commission's concern about fire trucks and trucks making turns from Country Club to Northwood. He recommended preliminary conditional land development approval pending submission of truck turning templates and modifications to the road as necessary.
- M. Boucher made a motion to approve the waiver from SALDO Article 7, Section 701. S. Brown seconded. A. Templeton abstained. Motion passed (4-0).
- N. Teague made a motion to approve the waiver from SALDO Article 7, Section 773.2. S. Brown seconded. A. Templeton abstained. Motion passed (4-0).
- M. Boucher made a motion to approve the waiver from SALDO Article 7, Section 774.32.E. S. Brown seconded. A. Templeton abstained. Motion passed (4-0).
- M. Boucher made a motion to approve the waiver from Bushkill Creek Watershed Management Ordinance Article 3 Section 306.B & Section 304.T. N. Teague seconded. A. Templeton abstained. Motion passed (4-0).
- N. Teague made a motion to grant preliminary conditional approval pending submission of truck turning templates and modifications to the road as necessary. S. Brown seconded. A. Templeton abstained. Motion passed (4-0).

Solicitor's Report - No reports.

Engineer's Report

<u>Triple Net 4730 Hanoverville Road Off-Site Improvements – Security Release</u> – J. Coyle reviewed his letter recommending the release of security. N. Teague made a motion to release the security. M. Boucher seconded. Motion passed (5-0).

J. Coyle reviewed his report for August 2025. He reported that the Butztown Road project begins Sept 8th. Verizon is scheduled to relocate the poles by this Friday. If so, they can start on the PADOT side. Hopefully this work can be completed before cold weather prevents the work.

Manager's Report

<u>2026 MMO – Defined Benefit</u> – L. Stauffer presented the DB MMO to the Board. M. Boucher made a motion acknowledging receipt of the 2026 MMO for defined benefits. N. Teague seconded. Motion passed (5-0).

<u>2026 MMO – Defined Contribution</u> – L. Stauffer presented the DC MMO. A. Templeton made a motion acknowledging receipt of the 2026 MMO for defined contributions. S. Brown seconded. Motion passed (5-0).

<u>Highway Reconstruction / Rehabilitation CD Investment – Resolution #LNT-31-25</u> – L. Stauffer explained that her and the Township Treasurer discussed investing funds to earn better interest. N. Teague made a motion to approve resolution #LNT-31-25. S. Brown seconded. Motion passed (5-0).

<u>Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company Study</u> – L. Stauffer reported that the Hanover Township Manager requested to meet to discuss regionalization of the two volunteer ire companies. Hanover Township has only 10 active volunteers and response to calls is dwindling. He inquired if Lower Nazareth wanted to participate in the study and cost. J. Pennington agreed that getting volunteers is a struggle and foresees this might be needed in the future. L. Stauffer noted that we have a great partnership with HVFC and it is important to get them involved early.

M. Boucher said they have a good working relationship with Hanover Township Fire Company but there are a lot of unknowns so they would need to sit down with them. He believes this is the future, but we should take our time. S. Brown and M. Boucher can meet with HVFC to discuss.

Payment of the Bills

M. Boucher made a motion to pay the bills as presented. N. Teague seconded. Motion passed (5-0).

Courtesy of the Floor

Robert Mills, 7451 Township Line, is an East Allen resident. He noted that he is not in favor of improving Township Line Road. He is concerned about speeding and reckless driving on the improved road. J. Pennington stated that Township Line is frequently a detour for PADOT and that a poor road can be just as unsafe. He said that safety issues will be addressed if the roadway is improved. N. Teague asked L. Stauffer if we could work with East Allen on traffic calming. L. Stauffer said it would be included in the bid specs.
