Mr. Pennington acknowledged the receipt of the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company Incident Reports for December 2015 and 2015 Totals, the Financial Report for November 2015, and Zoning Administrator's 2015 Report.

## Correspondence

### Subdivision and Land Development

<u>Hanoverville Road Sewer Service Area Planning Module – Resolution #LNT-09-16</u> — Originally approved in 2015, due to a problem with advertisement of the proposed resolution, this resolution needs to be re-approved now that the requirement has been met. A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was second by Mr. Kucsan to approve Resolution #LNT-09-16. The motion carried.

## Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Kucsan, Mr. Nagle, and Mr. Boucher had no comments.

Mr. Green reported that he read an article in the Express Times listing the municipalities with highest median home sales price; with Lower Nazareth being the highest at over \$300,000.

Mr. Pennington provided an update on LVPC's review of the Comprehensive Plan. He stated that all supervisors should review the report and provide comments.

Board of Supervisors Minutes January 13, 2016 Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) January 2016 – Resolution #LNT-08-16 – A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Green to approve Resolution #LNT-08-16. The motion carried.

Equipment Acquisition — 2016 Pick-Up Truck — Mr. Tenges requested to purchase a 2016 GMC Sierra, for roughly \$52,000.00, to replace an older vehicle. Mr. Tenges indicated that he would like to lease the equipment and would discuss the municipal lease options at our next meeting. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to authorize the purchase of equipment. The motion carried.

<u>Yard Waste Facility</u> – Mr. Tenges stated that when our Yard Waste Facility reopens for the 2016 season, weather pending in March 2016, residents will no longer need to make appointments to drop off their yard waste.

## Engineer's Report

<u>Traditions of America – Security Release</u> – Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter and recommended the release of the remaining security. A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to release the letter of credit. The motion carried.

### Solicitor's Report

Solicitor Asteak reported that Judge Baratta's opinion on the K&S Appeal supports the Board's decision to deny the Curative Amendment and that our zoning ordinance is sound; not flawed as indicated by the applicant.

### Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Green to approve payment of the bills dated January 13, 2016. The motion carried.

## Courtesy of the Floor

Laurie Ehasz, 4460 Hanoverville Road, spoke of truck traffic concerns on Hanoverville Road. She supplied a police report and photos of a tree that was recently knocked down by a tractor trailer causing property damage and a power outage. Ms. Ehasz stated that when she stopped a driver and told him he wasn't permitted on this street he stated that the instructions from C&S told him to take that route. Mr. Tenges said they were told by C&S that they were not directly drivers to use Hanoverville Road. They will reach out and follow up.

Mr. Tenges stated that if the residents want this to stop they need to get as much information about these trucks as they can; trucking company name, license plate, etc. and report it to the police. These fines are costly and will certainly deter these trucks from continuing to ignore the signs. Mr. Pennington and Mr. Boucher will also discuss this at the next Colonial Regional Police Commission (CRPC) meeting.
