Subdivision and Land Development

<u>Keystone Shed Company – Preliminary/Final Land Development – Resolution #LNT-07-15</u> – Mr. Kortze reviewed his April 2nd letter. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Green to approve Resolution #LNT-07-15. The motion carried.

<u>Joseph Leo – Easement Waiver Request</u> – Mary and Joseph Leo gave a brief presentation on their request to place a shed within the easement on their property. There is limited location to place the shed due to the lay-out of their lot. Mr. Kortze gave a brief report and did not have any issues with the request so long as they stay 10-15 feet from the pipe and stay 10 feet from their property line.

Mr. Tenges reported that they need to know that they will be responsible for any expenses (\$350) for the Solicitor to draft and record an agreement.

Conditional Use Hearing – Liberty Property Trust CU#2014-01

Solicitor Asteak gave a brief recap on the conditional use proceedings. Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law have been received by the applicant, marked as exhibit #A-7 and from Thomas Stitt marked as exhibit #Cardinal II. Transcripts will be available to Board members who may have missed one or more of the hearings.

Solicitor Asteak called on Thomas Stitt and James Preston to make their closing arguments.

Mr. Stitt reviewed his comments but concentrated mostly on traffic concerns. Solicitor Asteak and Mr. Stitt discussed whether a condition of approval should be the PennDot approval and even to have the Township Engineer review the plan.

Mr. Preston discussed conditional use and compliance with the Township's Zoning Ordinance. He also discussed PennDot's letter which is not a rejection; but a review letter with comments. The requirement for an HOP, at this step, should not be required. He cited that a plan can be recorded conditioned on getting an HOP prior to building on the site so how should the applicant need one to gain conditional use. Mr. Preston also discussed the proposed connector road.

Solicitor Asteak closed the record. The Board has 45 days to render a decision.

A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Nagle to adjourn the meeting at 7:45PM.
