LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES April 12, 2017

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting at the Lower Nazareth Municipal Building on Wednesday April 12, 2017. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve the March 8th meeting minutes. The motion carried.

Reports (Reports are available to review at the Township Office and on our website.)

Mr. Pennington acknowledged the receipt of the Financial Report for February and the Hecktown Fire Report for March 2017.

Correspondence

There were no comments under Correspondence.

Subdivision and Land Development

<u>Charles Chrin Preliminary/Final Minor Subdivision Plan</u> Withdrawal – The Board acknowledged the withdrawal of the Charles Chrin Preliminary/Final Minor Subdivision Plan per Attorney Goudsouzian's letter dated March 21, 2017.

Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Kucsan, Mr. Green, and Mr. Boucher had no comments. Mr. Pennington stated that he attended the CRPC meeting.

Manager's Report

<u>Nazareth Library Board Member Resignation</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that Mr. Howell has resigned from the Library Board therefore there is an opening for a Township Representative on the Board. Any interested parties should send a letter of interest to the Township. The Township will send a letter to thank Mr. Howell for his representation.

<u>Time Extension Report</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that the Township accepted a time extension for the IDI project through October 12, 2017.

Nazareth Area Council of Governments – Intermunicipal Agreement – Comp Plan Update – Solicitor Asteak stated the agreement provides for the costs per municipality (calculated on a per capita rate), payable over a three year period. A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to execute the agreement. The motion carried.

<u>East Penn Sanitation – Permit Renewal</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that East Penn has applied to DEP for a permit renewal for their transfer station on Hanoverville Road. DEP allows for a comment period. The Township has never received any complaints about them and therefore has no issue with the permit renewal.

Spring Newsletters – Mr. Tenges indicated that everyone should have received their Spring Newsletter.

<u>Trio Inquiry / Open Space</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that Solicitor Asteak has an answer to their inquiry on taxes on open space within their community. Solicitor Asteak indicated it is taxable and that the HOA will be responsible for those taxes once the HOA takes ownership. Jeff Shepherd, 4485 Whitetail Drive, inquired on the assessment, to which Solicitor Asteak told him to contact Northampton County.

Engineer's Report

<u>Tennis & Basketball Court Restoration</u> – Mr. Kortze reported that he will be scheduling a meeting with the contractor to finish the restoration project.

Solicitor's Report

<u>Sanitary Sewer Easement Agreement – Everson Tesla – Authorization to Execute</u> – The agreement between Everson Tesla, Kay-Trio, Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority, and Lower Nazareth will hold the Township harmless. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to authorize execution of the agreement. Jeff Shepherd, 4485 Whitetail Drive, inquired about the pump station and on the responsibility of its maintenance. Mr. Tenges reported Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority. The motion carried.

Medical Marijuana Ordinance – Authorization to Advertise – Solicitor Asteak reported that this ordinance will be forwarded to LVPC and the LNT Planning Commission for review and comment. The ordinance will be on the agenda for our second meeting in May. A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to authorize advertisement of the ordinance for adoption at our May 24th meeting. Jeff Shepherd, 4485 Whitetail Drive, inquired how they can keep these facilities away from their neighborhood. Solicitor Asteak explained that part of purpose of the ordinance to control where facilities are permitted. Mrs. Seese indicated on the zoning map the area, along Route 248 and Route 33, where they will be permitted. The motion carried.

<u>Liquor License Transfer – Authorization to Advertise</u> – Solicitor Asteak indicated that the Township has received a request for a hearing on a Intermunicipal liquor license transfer for Giant Food Stores located on Nazareth Pike. Giant will be operating a restaurant inside their store where it will sell beer for consumption on the premises and beer or wine "to go." A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to authorize advertisement of a hearing for the liquor license transfer. The motion carried.

Old Business

There was no discussion under Old Business.

New Business

There was no discussion under New Business.

Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve payment of the bills dated April 12, 2017. The motion carried.

Courtesy of the Floor

Michael Bohl, 451 Larch Lane, inquired if there was any way the Township could put pressure on the County to get the Georgetown Bridge project completed. Mr. Tenges and Mr. Pennington explained that there are many factors that have delayed the project included the proximity to the train tracks and the creek. Mr. Bohl stressed his concern for speeding once this and the Township's improvements on Georgetown Road are complete and asked the Board to do something ask CRPD to post a speed meter to alert drivers to slow down. Mr. Pennington stated we could look into posting the meter.

Jeff & Renae Shepherd, 4485 Whitetail Drive, along with Tammy Kenny, 641 Mulberry Drive, expressed concern over numerous traffic and parking violations within their community. The Board stated that until the Township accepts the roads, they are private and therefore the police have no jurisdiction in regards to traffic violations. Mr. Shepherd said the HOA has met with Kay Builders and asked that they post appropriate signage and Kay Builders stated they want to work with the Township to get their recommendations. Mr. Tenges stated that he will discuss the matter with Mr. Kortze. While the Board understood the residents' concerns they reiterated that the Township holds no liability as it is private property and liability falls on Kay Builders.
