### LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES May 13, 2020

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a virtual meeting on Wednesday May 13, 2020. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

### **Approval of Minutes**

A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Brown to approve the April 8<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

Reports (Reports are available to review at the Township Office and on our website.)

Mr. Pennington acknowledged the receipt of the Hecktown Fire Report for March and April 2020, the Colonial Regional Police 2019 Annual Report, and the Financial Report for March 2020.

Solicitor Asteak noted the high number of false alarms and noted that we should be sending violation notices. He also commented on the problem with retail theft and that we should have the stores' loss prevention deal with these cases and not call in the police.

### **Supervisors' Comments**

Mr. Brown commented that residents were very happy for the yard waste collection event last Saturday.

Mr. Boucher noted that Hecktown is doing well. He commented that everyone is looking forward to Clean Up Day.

Mr. Hoyer noted that the Environmental Advisory Council met on May 11<sup>th</sup>. He also commented on the great job by the Public Works Crew with the pipe replacement project at Newburg and Country Club Roads.

Ms. Templeton gave an update on library operations during the pandemic.

Mr. Pennington had no additional comments.

### Solicitor's Report

<u>Tax Assessment Appeal - BBT</u> – Solicitor Asteak reported that the assessment change would result in a minimal decreased in tax revenue and recommended approving the change. He noted that both Northampton County and the Nazareth School District already approved the changed. A motion was moved by Mr. Hoyer and was seconded by Mr. Boucher authorizing approval of the assessment change. The motion carried unanimously.

### **Engineer's Report**

<u>CarMax Letter of Credit Reduction</u> – Mr. Kortze provided a letter recommending a reduction in security. A motion was moved by Mr. Hoyer and was seconded by Mr. Brown authorizing a reduction in the letter of credit per the Township Engineer's recommendation. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Springwood Hospitality – Tru 2 Home – Letter of Credit Reduction</u> – Mr. Kortze provided a letter recommending a reduction in security. A motion was moved by Mr. Hoyer and was seconded by Ms. Templeton authorizing a reduction in the letter of credit per the Township Engineer's recommendation. The motion carried unanimously.

Walking Trail Update – Mr. Kortze reported that construction should begin on May 26th or 27th.

<u>Park Restrooms</u> – Mr. Kortze reported construction of the bathrooms is currently out to bid. To date, there have been 80 downloads of the specs. The pre-bid meeting is scheduled for May 20<sup>th</sup> and the bid opening in June 5<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Recycling Facility Fencing Specs</u> – Mr. Kortze stated that the ad will run on Friday and the bids will be opened on June 19<sup>th</sup>.

<u>LVHN</u> – Mr. Kortze said the project in moving along and the crews are working 10-hour days.

<u>Springwood Hospitality</u> – Mrs. Seese noted they are finished and received temporary occupancy at the end of March. Mr. Kortze noted there are a few outstanding items that need to be addressed.

<u>CarMax</u> – Mrs. Seese noted they have received occupancy.

### Manager's Report

Earned Income and Real Estate Tax Revenue to Date – Ms. Stauffer reported that to date we have received \$1,600,216.83 in real estate revenue; \$242,672.76 remains uncollected. As for earned income tax we saw a slight decrease from previous years. She anticipates we will see larger decreases in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters. Mr. Pennington noted this will affect not only the 2020 budget but the 2021 budget as well.

<u>Lehigh Valley Greenways Grant Extension</u> – Ms. Stauffer stated this grant covers 50% of the township map project. She received an email stating that due to the pandemic they are offering an extension on completing this project through December 31, 2020. Ms. Stauffer will apply for that extension.

<u>CDBG Grant Application</u> – Ms. Stauffer has submitted an application for funds towards the paving of the Senior Center Parking Lot.

<u>Hecktown Fire Company Grant</u> – Ms. Stauffer is working with Chief Seip to apply for a Northampton County Grant Program; a \$10,000 maximum towards training equipment.

Newburg Inn Demolition – Ms. Stauffer said Mr. Kortze has been authorized to prepare the demolition bids documents.

<u>DEP Application 902 Grant</u> – Ms. Stauffer reported that we applied for a grant from DEP for \$206,573.00 towards equipment and improvements to our recycling facility.

<u>Yard Waste Facility</u> – Ms. Stauffer said the yard waste facility would be open again this Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup> from 8am – 3pm. The facility would open regular hours beginning Friday May 29<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Colonial Regional Police Grant</u> – Ms. Stauffer is working with Chief Seiple on two grants: Northampton County CIPP for \$21,000 and Northampton/Lehigh County LSA for \$21,000 (totaling \$42,000) towards new radios.

Real Estate Tax Deadline Extensions – Resolution #LNT-15-20 – Ms. Stauffer noted that the Board approved these tax deadline extensions at their March 25<sup>th</sup> meeting however Act 15 requires us to adopt a resolution to ratify that decision. A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to adopt resolution #LNT-15-20. The motion carried unanimously. Ms. Stauffer noted that the Secretary/Treasurer is required to forward this to the Real Estate Tax Collector.

<u>DCED Greenways</u>, <u>Trails</u>, and <u>Recreation Grant Application – #LNT-16-20</u> – Ms. Stauffer noted this grant application is for the Phase I improvements at Surrey Glen Park. A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Brown to adopt resolution #LNT-16-20. The motion carried unanimously.

### Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve payment of the bills dated May 13<sup>th</sup>. The motion carried unanimously.

Courtesy of the Floor -There we no comments under Courtesy of the Floor.

Adjournment - The meeting adjourned at 6:56 PM.
