### LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES

June 10, 2020

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a virtual meeting on Wednesday June 10, 2020. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

### **Approval of Minutes**

A motion was moved by Mr. Hoyer and was seconded by Ms. Templeton to approve the May 13<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

Reports (Reports are available to review at the Township Office and on our website.)

Mr. Pennington acknowledged the receipt of the Financial Report for April 2020 and the Planning and Zoning Administrator's Report for the months of January through May 2020.

### Recreation, Parks, Open Space Preservation Discussion

Ms. Stauffer indicated that Kent Baird of the Gilmore Group, spoke with the Environmental Advisory Council (EAC) at their meeting on Monday's evening about the plan and map. Mr. Hoyer stated that the EAC put a lot of time into the plan which include walking and biking trails and connections between developments and parks.

She also indicated that the Township has requested an extension on the grant through December 31st for the update to the Township map.

Mr. Baird gave a brief presentation on the map and plan updates. There was discussion on locations on trails, farmland preservation, open space, as well as connector roads and trails.

Ms. Stauffer stated Mr. Baird would make revisions based on the Board's comments and provide them to the Board by Tuesday.

### **Supervisors' Comments**

Mr. Brown had no comments.

Mr. Boucher gave an update on Hecktown Fire and the current pandemic.

Mr. Hoyer noted that the Environmental Advisory Council met on June 8th.

Ms. Templeton gave an update on library operations during the pandemic.

Mr. Pennington stated that there was no COG meeting for June. The next meeting will be in July.

### **Subdivision & Land Development**

<u>CTS Improvements Agreement</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Hoyer and was seconded by Mr. Hoyer to approve the CTS improvements agreement. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>CTS Holding Tank Agreement</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Ms. Templeton to approve the CTS holding tank agreement. The motion carried unanimously.

#### Solicitor's Report

There we no comments under Solicitor's Report.

### **Engineer's Report**

<u>Walking Trail – Barwis Construction Payment #1</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Ms. Templeton to approve the first payment for the walking trail. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Walking Trail Update</u> – Mr. Kortze reported the trail has been cut in and stonework is being completed. The trail surface in the wooded area should be completed this week and the pave portion will be worked on next week.

<u>Recycling Facility Fencing</u> – Mr. Kortze noted there is an on-site meeting for the fence tomorrow. The project is currently out to bid.

<u>Newburg Inn Demolition</u> – Mr. Kortze is gathering quotes for the demolition of the Newburg Inn. Samples will be required to test for hazardous materials. A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Mr. Hoyer to authorize inspections up to \$5,000 for the material samples needed. The motion carried unanimously.

#### Manager's Report

<u>Time Extension Report</u> – Ms. Stauffer reported that the township accepted a time extension for Trammel Crow for their Conditional Use Application through August 31, 2020.

Small Bathroom Bid Award – Ms. Stauffer commented that although there was a lot of interested parties, we only received two bids. The lowest bid came in \$125,000 higher than Mr. Kortze's estimate. The low bidder, Kobalt Construction, came in at \$296,969.00. Ms. Stauffer noted that the total cost for the walking trail and the small bathroom is \$561,000. The Township was awarded \$355,000 in grants towards those projects; therefore, the out of pocket expense to the Township for both projects is \$206,000. A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to award the bid to Kobalt Construction. The motion carried unanimously. Ms. Stauffer asked Mr. Kortze to notify the winning bidder. Mr. Kortze noted there is a 90-day lead time therefore construction is likely to begin in the fall.

<u>Newburg Inn Contents Auction</u> – Ms. Stauffer reported that she is in receipt of two bids for the auction of the contents of the Newburg Inn but would like to obtain a third bid. The matter was tabled to a future meeting.

Northampton County EMS Grant - Ms. Stauffer reported she is working on a grant for the fire company. The amount is up to \$10,000 and requires a 50/50 match. A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Brown to authorize the \$10,000 match for the grant. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Closing on Newburg Inn</u> – Ms. Stauffer reported that the Township will be closing on the Newburg Inn next week. A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Brown to authorize Ms. Stauffer to execute the closing documents. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Manager's Report</u> – Ms. Stauffer submitted her report to the Board, and they can reach out to her with any questions.

<u>CRPD Radio Update</u> – Ms. Stauffer was applying for grants to cover the \$42,000 cost to replace the police radios. She was applying for \$21,000 through the Northampton County CIPP Grant and \$21,000 through the LAS Program. Unfortunately, the LAS program was canceled for this year.

### Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Ms. Templeton to approve payment of the bills dated June 10<sup>th</sup>. The motion carried unanimously.

### **Courtesy of the Floor**

There we no comments under Courtesy of the Floor.
