The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting at the Lower Nazareth Municipal Building on Wednesday June 25, 2014. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Mr. Nagle acknowledged the receipt of the Financial Report for May.

#### Correspondence

#### Subdivision and Land Development

Brint Drainage and Utility Easement Waiver — Mike and Joan Brint were present to request the waiver. They would like to place a fence within the easement. Mr. and Mrs. Brint stated they would be willing to cover any cost to remove the fence if the easement is ever needed. Mr. Kortze had no issues with the waiver request. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Pennington to approve the waiver request. The motion carried. Solicitor Asteak will draft the legal paperwork.

<u>298 Keystone Drive Conditional Use – Application Withdrawal</u> – The Township is in receipt of a letter from Dent Design Hardware withdrawing their Conditional Use Application.

#### Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Nagle reported that due to work commitments he would be resigning as the CRPC Delegate. He nominated Mr. Green to fill the position. Mr. Green nominated Mr. Boucher. Mr. Nagle and Mr. Kucsan voted for Mr. Green. Mr. Pennington, Mr. Green, and Mr. Boucher voted for Mr. Boucher. Mr. Boucher will be the new CRPC Delegate.

Mr. Nagle also resigned as Chairman of the Board. Mr. Green nominated Mr. Pennington. Everyone voted in favor of Mr. Pennington as Chair. The Board thanked Mr. Nagle for his service.

Mr. Boucher nominated Mr. Green as Vice-Chair. Everyone voted in favor of Mr. Green as Vice-Chair.

#### Manager's Report

<u>Time Extension Report</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that we accepted a time extension for the Fields at Trio Farms Phase III, through November 4, 2014.

<u>High Density Filing System – 623 Municipal Drive</u> – Mr. Tenges stated that the office has numerous files; many, like property files, need to be kept in perpetuity. Therefore would like to purchase a filing system from Reynolds Business Systems for \$26,630.78. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and Mr. Green to authorize the purchase of the high density filing system. The motion carried. Mr. Tenges updated the Board on the progress at 623 Municipal Drive and stated that he hopes to have the Administration portion complete and ready to move in by September and the meeting space completed by November.

Zoning Hearing Board Alternate Application – Mr. Tenges indicated that we have received a letter of interest from Daniel Cortright to be an alternate on the Zoning Hearing Board. A motion to appoint Mr. Cortright as an alternate on the Zoning Hearing Board was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Green. The motion carried.

Notice of Violation from EPA — Mr. Tenges reported that this is actually just a communication error. The issue was in the area of Public Outreach. They were unaware that we do the following: annually run an advertisement in the Express, have pamphlets available in our lobby, provide documents with all permits, and we have a link to DEP on our website. Mr. Tenges stated that he is looking into adding this information to our website.

<u>2014 FDR Bids</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that Easton Suburban Water Authority will be replacing the system in the subdivision originally scheduled for this year's FDR project. Those roads are Oakwood, Dogwood, Elm, and Birch. Therefore, we will push that subdivision back to next year. Instead, we will repair Little Creek Drive. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Green to authorize the advertisement for bids for the 2014 FDR project. The motion carried.

Northwood Avenue Roadwork – Mr. Tenges reported that Public Works recently did a paver demo and repaved Northwood Avenue from Newburg Road to Corrierre Road. They are currently doing a different paver demo and are paving Georgetown Road from Newburg Road to Upper Nazareth Township. Mr. Pennington commented that Northwood is much nicer and has received positive comments from residents.
