The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting at the Lower Nazareth Municipal Building on Wednesday August 9, 2017. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve the July 12th meeting minutes. The motion carried.

Reports (Reports are available to review at the Township Office and on our website.)

Mr. Pennington acknowledged the receipt of the Financial Report for June 2017, Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company Incident Report for July 2017, and the Zoning Administrator's Report for June 2017.

Mr. Pennington thanked Hecktown Fire Company for their recent service during the storms last week. He noted that in one afternoon there was a drowning at Dutch Springs, a house fire on Cobblestone Lane, and a pole down on Hecktown Road.

Correspondence

Bath Borough's Withdrawal from CRPC – Mr. Tenges read a letter dated July 13th from Brad Flynn, Manager of Bath Borough, giving notice of their withdrawal effective January 1, 2019.

Manager's Retirement – Mr. Pennington read Mr. Tenges' letter announcing his retirement effective February 6, 2018. Mr. Pennington thanked Mr. Tenges for all his hard work. A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Nagle to accept Mr. Tenges notice of retirement. The motion carried.

Subdivision and Land Development - There was no discussion under Subdivision & Land Development.

Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Kucsan, and Mr. Green had no comments. Mr. Nagle thanked Mr. Tenges for all he has done for the Township during his 30+ years of service. Mr. Pennington stated that he attended the Joint COG and CRPC meetings this month.

Manager's Report

<u>Wide Format Printer</u> – Mr. Tenges stated that this piece of equipment is a printer, copier, and scanner and will assist the Township in meeting our MS4 requirements. In addition, it will help in archiving to reduce paper documents. The printer will be purchased from Edwards for \$32,461.00 and is on the COSTARS contract. Mr.

Board of Supervisors Minutes August 9, 2017 Tenges notes that the funds have already been set aside for this equipment purchase. A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve the printer purchase. The motion carried.

<u>Masonry Mailbox – 268 Cobblestone Lane</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Green to approve the masonry mailbox agreement. The motion carried.

Wheel Loader Purchase – Mr. Tenges reported that our current wheel loader is a 1998 and has been giving us problems. In fact, it quit working today while being utilized for the Georgetown Road project. We have been demoing a John Deere and a CAT in order to decide which to purchase. Mr. Tenges asked for authorization to purchase a new loader up to \$170,000.00 and to sign a lease with Lafayette Ambassador Bank. He noted that funds have been set aside for equipment replacement. A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Green to authorize the purchase and to execute a lease with Lafayette Ambassador Bank. The motion carried.

<u>Retirement</u> – Mr. Tenges stated that it has been a pleasure working here and he truly does have mixed emotions about his retirement. He said he loves what he does and is going to miss it.

Solicitor's Report - There was no discussion under Solicitor's Report.

Engineer's Report

Mr. Pennington asked Mr. Kortze for an update on the Hartman Road extension. Mr. Kortze reported that the design is complete he just needs to discuss some items with Solicitor Asteak.

Mr. Pennington asked Mr. Kortze for a status on the new traffic signals on Hanoverville Road. Mr. Kortze states they are moving along and are more than likely waiting for the poles. Mr. Tenges added that there are limited manufacturers and there is a 4 month wait for poles.

Old Business - There was no discussion under Old Business.

New Business - There was no discussion under New Business.

Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Nagle to approve payment of the bills dated August 9, 2017. The motion carried.

Courtesy of the Floor

Bert Smalley, 4335 King George Drive, asked about the hearing on Liberty Properties. Mr. Pennington stated the hearing was postponed for a few months. Mr. Mills added that the judge would like to see the parties settle this on their own.
