#### LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES SEPTEMBER 12, 2012

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting in the Township Municipal Building on Wednesday September 12, 2012. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:38 PM.

#### **Approval of Minutes**

A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve the meeting minutes for August 8, 2012. Mr. Pennington and Mr. Boucher abstained. The motion carried.

#### Reports

All reports are available to review at the Township Office and on our website.

Mr. Nagle acknowledged the receipt of the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company Incident Report for August 2012, the Hecktown Volunteer Ambulance Corps Incident Reports for May, June & July, the Financial Report for June 2012, and the Zoning Administrator's Report for August 2012.

#### Correspondence

There were no items to discuss under Correspondence.

#### Subdivision and Land Development

<u>Griffin Sewage Facilities Planning Module – Resolution #LNT-16-12</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Pennington and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve resolution #LNT-16-12. The motion carried.

#### **Supervisors' Comments**

Mr. Kucsan, Mr. Green, and Mr. Boucher had no comments.

Mr. Pennington attended the CRPC meeting on August 27<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Nagle also attended the CRPC meeting. He reported that they started looking at the 2013 budget.

#### Manager's Report

<u>Christian Springs Road Update</u> – The rehabilitation and paving is complete. They are continuing to work on shoulder restoration and grading. The road will also need to be striped.

Mr. Tenges reported that the township is closer to executing the agreement with ISC; however until we reach settlement it may be too late to conduct the work and it will have to be completed in the spring.

Board of Supervisors Minutes September 12, 2012 <u>PPL Complaint</u> – Mr. Tenges reminded the Board of a resident's complaint regarding power outages. Mr. Tenges met with PPL and they provided an explanation of the outages. All outages were a result of weather, traffic accidents or human error. Different neighborhoods are on different circuits so it is possible to be without power while the neighbors across the street have power.

<u>FEMA Flood Map Update</u> – Mr. Tenges commented that FEMA updated the Flood Map throughout Northampton County. Lower Nazareth Township had nothing to do with this change and merely sent the letters out as a courtesy to our residents.

<u>2012 FDR Road Project</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that the 2012 FDR project is set to start the week of September 17<sup>th</sup> and should be completed in about 8 days, weather pending.

<u>Property Maintenance Issues with Abandoned Properties</u> – Mr. Tenges explained that we are having issues with property maintenance with abandoned properties. Solicitor Asteak commented that we could cut the grass and then bill the property owners. Mrs. Seese commented that sometimes properties are maintained but when the mortgage is sold there is a lapse in property maintenance. Solicitor Asteak stated that even though we can take the property owner to the magistrate, fines are rarely levied by the magistrate.

Mr. Tenges stated that we could develop a policy for these issues. Mr. Nagle agreed that the Board could think about it and discuss the matter.

<u>Hollo Road – Road Project</u> – The Fiber Mat project is complete. Mr. Tenges reported that he is fairly pleased with the outcome. The road still needs to be striped.

Miracle League Ball Field - Mr. Tenges attended the ribbon cutting on Sunday September 9th.

#### **Engineer's Report**

<u>Nazareth Crossings – Pad Site "A" – Maintenance Release</u> – Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter recommending the release of the remaining \$1,373.75 in security. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Pennington to authorize the release of the remaining security. The motion carried.

<u>Nazareth Crossings – WaWa – Maintenance Release</u> –Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter recommending the release of the remaining \$527.00 in security. A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Green to authorize the release of the remaining security. The motion carried.

<u>George Manja – Maintenance Release</u> –Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter recommending the release of the remaining \$4,603.00 in security. A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to authorize the release of the remaining security. The motion carried.

#### Solicitor's Report

<u>Masonry Mailbox Agreement</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Pennington to approve the masonry mailbox agreement. The motion carried.

<u>Stipulation of Settlement of Eminent Domain – DeBonis</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Green and was seconded by Mr. Pennington to approve the payment of \$2,400.00 and to execute the agreement. The motion carried.

<u>Agreement of Sale – ISC Property – Authorization to Execute</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Pennington to authorize execution of the agreement of sale. The motion carried.

<u>Trinity Church Property</u> – Solicitor Asteak reported that the agreement of sale for the "triangle" has been executed.

AAA Tax Assessment Appeal – Solicitor Asteak reported that the tax assessment is complete.

<u>Selvaggio Litigation</u> – Solicitor Asteak reported that this is crawling along and will hopefully go to trial in October.

#### **New Business**

#### Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve payment of the bills dated September 12, 2012. The motion carried.

<u>Claude Beck, 4256 Christian Springs Road</u>, will be filing an appeal with FEMA and needs blueprints and elevations from the township. Mr. Kortze was authorized to provide Mr. Beck with the required documents; however Mr. Beck may still be required to hire someone to shoot elevations for him.

<u>Bill Schuch, 4291 Christian Springs Road,</u> requested speed bumps on Christian Springs Road. Mr. Tenges commented that if we used speed to determine where to install speed bumps, they would be on every road in the township. The Board could consider it, but it would be opening Pandora's Box. The Board agreed.

#### <u>Adjournment</u>

A motion was moved by Mr. Pennington and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:27pm.
