To: Residents of Lower Nazareth Township residing on the following streets:

- 1) Timberlea Drive (in its entirety), beginning at the intersection of Newburg Road and ending at the cul-de-sac (TR 587)
- 2) Fir Drive, beginning at the intersection of Timberlea Drive and ending at a point 50' west of Magnolia Drive (TR5890)
- 3) Ash Drive, beginning at the intersection of Fir Drive and ending at a point 50' west of Magnolia Drive (TR535)
- 4) Magnolia Drive (in its entirety) including stub road to dead end (TR600)

Keystone Stabilization LLC ("Keystone"), as part of Lower Nazareth Township's commitment to local infrastructure improvement, has been contracted to perform roadwork on the street abutting your property.

Work to be done on your street by Keystone, including pulverization/ Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR) with Portland Cement additive, is scheduled to begin July 27th, 2020 (weather permitting). We hope to conclude our operation by August 7th, 2020. Once the base material is cured, Township forces will begin the third phase of the project.

The following parking restrictions will be in place during all three phases of construction. We would appreciate and ask for your cooperation in tolerating this directive. (Vehicles will be towed as a last resort).

NO STREET PARKING BETWEEN 6:00AM - 6:00PM MONDAY-FRIDAY

There may be brief periods during the workday when the street in front of your property will be under a supervised traffic control pattern. However, all efforts will be made to minimize traffic delays. Please use extreme caution while driving your vehicle through the construction area. Your adherence to traffic control instructions will minimize your contact with construction materials and vehicles.
