LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES February 25, 2009

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a regularly scheduled meeting in the Township Municipal Building on Wednesday February 25, 2009. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve the meeting minutes for January 28, 2009. The motion carried.

Reports

Reports are available for review at the Township Office.

Dr. Dilsaver acknowledged the receipt of the January 2009 Financial Report, the Zoning Administrator's January 2009 Report and the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company January 2009 Incident Report.

Library representative, Laurie Jordan, presented the Board with the Nazareth Are Memorial Library 2008 Annual Report. Ms. Jordan reported that even with the reduced hours of operation, the number of residents using the library has gone up. Ms. Jordan also discussed services and programs available at the library. Funding of the library was discussed and Mr. Tenges, along with Mr. Kucsan, voiced his concerns that the townships are no longer invited to sit on the budget committee.

Correspondence

There were no items to discuss under Correspondence.

Subdivision and Land Development

There were no items to discuss under Subdivision and Land Development.

Supervisor's Comments

Mr. Kucsan discussed his concern about outdoor furnaces that are a nuisance to residents. He suggested the township adopt an ordinance limiting the use of these furnaces in our community. Mr. Tenges

In addition, Solicitor Asteak suggested including solar panels. Mr. Tenges wanted to stress that the township isn't anti-green, but we want to integrate it properly into the community to protect residents' quality of life. A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and seconded by Mr. Nagle to research and prepare an ordinance covering outdoor furnaces, windmills, and solar panels. The motion carried.

Along with Mr. Kucsan, Mr. Nagle attended the CRPC meeting on Monday evening. Mr. Nagle reported that the Citizen Police Academy will run again this year. It will run every Wednesday from April 1st – June 17th from 7:00PM - 9:30PM. It is available on a first come first serve basis. You get a tour of the new police facility; learn the vehicle codes, crime codes, gun safety, tour 911 center, and more.

In addition, Mr. Nagle discussed CRPD annual report which includes crime data and statistics.

Dr. Dilsaver and Mr. Johnson had no comments.

Manager's Report

<u>PADOT on-line reporting – Resolution #LNT-06-09</u> – This resolution authorizes the use of online reporting for state liquid fuels. A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and seconded by Mr. Kucsan to approve Resolution #LNT-06-09. The motion carried

<u>COG meeting</u> – Mr. Tenges attended the COG Planning Meeting last night. Solicitor Asteak reported that the COG would assume additional \$6,078 financing for the purpose of obtaining the grant for the zoning study. Mr. Tenges stated that the planning meetings will be held the 2nd Monday of the month at 5:30PM at a location to be announced. They will be purchasing 11 generators for around \$10,000. Mr. Tenges spoke with Mr. Brackbill to reserve a 3,000 watt generator.

<u>Lower Nazareth Township Website Update</u> – Mr. Tenges stated the staff has been working on administrative issues as we move from development to maintenance of the website. The township made a commitment with Enternet to assist with the maintenance of our website.

NIMS training – Mr. Tenges reported that 5 staff members would be attending 16 hours of NIMS training in the coming weeks.

<u>Introductions</u> – Mr. Tenges introduced Christine Gerencher to the Board. In addition, Kelly Sullivan was present to answer any website questions. Also present was Edward Olenick who is currently the acting Public Works Supervisor.

Engineer's Report

Marquis Realty – Letter of Credit Reduction – Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter and recommended the letter of credit be reduced from \$61,891.20 to \$28,255.94. A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and seconded by Mr. Johnson to a \$33,635.26 reduction in the letter of credit. The motion carried.

Regency Realty (Lower Nazareth Commons) - Letter of Credit Reductions

<u>Corriere Road & Northwood Avenue</u> – Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter and recommended the letter of credit be reduced from \$2,400,505.20 to \$1,461,712.74. A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and seconded by Mr. Nagle to a \$938,792.46 reduction in the letter of credit. The motion carried.

<u>Lots 1 & 5</u> – Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter and recommended the letter of credit be reduced from \$2,135,401.32 to \$1,149,457.41. A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Nagle to a \$985,943.91 reduction in the letter of credit. The motion carried.

Payment of the Bills
