Approval of Minutes

A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve the meeting minutes for March 24, 2010. Mr. Kucsan abstained. The motion carried.

Old Business

<u>Selvaggio – Proposed Zoning Map Amendment</u> – Cliff Johnston spoke about how they were before the Board last month and had returned tonight hoping for the "green light" to move forward with their project.

Mr. Tenges had no comments.

Mr. Kucsan stated he was against the idea; fearing the traffic impact on the already stressed intersection on Route 191 and Newburg Road.

Mr. Nagle didn't believe the proposed uses were needed at this time and was not inclined to move forward with the project.

Mr. Johnson was not interested in the project at this time.

Mr. Boucher had no comment.

Mr. Johnston was disappointed and noted that the land will not remain in its present state and development will take place.

Board of Supervisors Minutes April 14, 2010

Subdivision and Land Development

Lowe's Home Centers, Inc. - Preliminary/Final Land Development - Resolution #LNT-09-10 -

Solicitor Asteak stated that Lowe's issues have been addressed and are now part of the resolution; which satisfies his concerns. A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve Resolution #LNT-09-10. The motion carried.

Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority - Final Site Plan - Resolution #LNT-10-10 -

Present was Justin Coyle and Dwayne Itterly. Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority is working with Kenyon Energy on this project. Kenyon Energy seeks grants for the project; without the grant the project won't happen.

The estimated 700 panels would be installed on 3 acres. The earth disturbance would be minimal; each panel is installed on 4 posts and grass will be planted under the panels. The panels will be 3-6 feet off the ground and at a 35° angle.

Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter dated April 8, 2010. The applicant brought an updated plan this evening therefore the resolution will need to be amended to reflect the changes and the new plan date.

A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to approve the amended Resolution #LNT-10-10. The motion carried.

Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Nagle and Mr. Kucsan had no comments.

Mr. Johnson sent his condolences to the Murphy family. Sally Murphy, wife of former Supervisor Patrick Murphy, passed away earlier that day.

Mr. Boucher commented that the new fire pumper truck was being picked up on Friday.

Manager's Report

ITS Easement Agreement- Authorization to Execute – Once this agreement is received, executed, from ITS, it will be reviewed to be sure it addresses all previous concerns. A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Kucsan to authorize execution of this agreement, subject to the township's review. A motion carried.

<u>Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company #1 – Loan Agreement</u> – Mr. Tenges stated that the fire company needs to borrow money towards the purchase of their new truck, just until the loan goes through. The money must be repaid no later than August 31, 2010. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Johnson to enter into this agreement with the fire company. The motion carried.

No Smoking Policy – Mr. Boucher briefly described his request for this policy. Mr. Tenges believes that adding this policy to the park rules, Ordinance #109, would be the best course of action. A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to authorize Mr. Tenges and Solicitor Asteak to amend the language in Ordinance #109. The motion carried.

Engineer's Report

Mr. Kortze reviewed his letter dated April 1, 2010. He recommended reducing the letter of credit from its current balance of \$152,893.20 to \$0. The two items mentioned in his letter have since been addressed.

Mr. Tenges stated that he believe that no maintenance period is required because all the improvements were internal and not subject to longevity issues.

A motion was moved by Mr. Johnson and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to release Brown-Daub's letter of credit. The motion carried.

Solicitor's Report

There were no items to discuss under Solicitor's Report.

New Business

There were no items to discuss under New Business.

Payment of the Bills

A motion was made by Mr. Kucsan and seconded by Mr. Johnson to approve the bills dated April 14, 2010. The motion carried.

Courtesy of the Floor

<u>Thomas Stitt</u>, whose law practice is at 576 Nazareth Pike; thanked the Board for not moving ahead with this proposal. His office would have been across the street from the proposed shopping center.

Adjournment

A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and seconded by Mr. Johnson to adjourn the meeting at 7:25PM.
