Subdivision and Land Development

<u>Keystone Foods – Waiver & Deferral Requests & Preliminary/Final Land Development –</u>
The applicant contacted the Township Office and requested to be removed from tonight's agenda. They need to resolve a hydrant access issue discussed in Fire Chief Seip's October 25th letter prior to being heard by the Board.

Brown-Daub Chevy Volvo – Preliminary/Final Site Plan – Resolution #LNT-23-09 – Chris Brown was present on behalf of the application. Mr. Brown stated the applicant is not ready for approval and requested a 60-90 day time extension. Mr. Tenges stated that an extension would be permitted but wanted a limited extension...perhaps 60 days. Mr. Brown granted a time extension through January 15, 2010. A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Nagle to accept the time extension through January 15th. The motion carried. Mr. Brown will follow up with a letter formally granting the time extension.

Supervisors' Comments

Mr. Kucsan and Dr. Dilsaver had no comments.

Mr. Johnson commented that he attended the County Convention on Friday and it was a nice evening.

Mr. Nagle commented that he, along with Mr. Kucsan, attended the CRPD meeting Monday night. They are continuing to work on the 2010 budget. In addition they discussed the use of 2 rooms at their building. Mr. Tenges commented that he will be meeting with Hanover Township to discuss.

Manager's Report

<u>Sidewalk and Curbing Maintenance Ordinance – Authorization to Advertise</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Johnson to authorize the solicitor to advertise this ordinance for approval at the November 18th Board of Supervisors meeting. The motion carried.

<u>Outdoor Solid Fuel Burning Appliance Ordinance – Authorization to Advertise</u> – This ordinance will not prohibit this appliance; only regulate location, chimney height, time of use, and items that can be burned.

A motion was moved by Mr. Kucsan and was seconded by Mr. Nagle to authorize the solicitor to advertise this ordinance for approval at the November 18th Board of Supervisors meeting. The motion carried.

<u>Authorization to advertise use of CPA to perform 2009 Audit</u> – A motion was moved by Mr. Nagle and was seconded by Mr. Johnson to authorize advertisement of the township's intent on appointing a CPA to perform the 2009 audit. The motion carried.

<u>Project Time Extension</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that the township accepted a time extension for the Mocha Abe Preliminary/Final Land Development plan. The previous project review period ended on October 31, 2008; the new deadline is October 31, 2010.

<u>Tax Collection Committee (TCC)</u> – Mr. Tenges attended at TCC meeting on Thursday evening. There is going to be additional costs for tax collection in 2010. We should be getting a bill soon; we need to fund the TCC and hire a solicitor.

<u>2010 Budget</u> – Mr. Tenges reported that the draft 2010 budget is almost complete. He hopes to have it ready for the Board to review in a few days. Mr. Tenges would like to get the Board's approval to advertise the budget at our next meeting; November 4th.

Solicitor's Report

Solicitor Asteak commented that the IDI Appeal is scheduled for next week at the Commonwealth Court in Schuylkill County.
