<u>Prologis Traffic Signal Application – Resolution #LNT-02-07</u> – Motion to grant Resolution #LNT-02-07 was moved by Mr. Nagle and seconded by Mr. Kucsan. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Tenges stated that when he forwards this resolution to PennDOT he will be including a few conditions in the cover letter. He will be requesting the signals be served with a battery back-up and for the controller cabinet to be relocated.

<u>Prologis Traffic Impact Fees – Resolution #LNT-03-07</u> – Motion to approve Resolution #LNT-03-07 which sets the Traffic Impact fee at \$261,765.00 was moved by Mr. Kucsan and seconded by Mr. Nagle. The motion carried unanimously.

Each township would pay 1/3 of the \$1.5 million purchase price of the building, plus other costs accrued like engineering fees, legal fees, and utility bills. Motion to grant Mr. Tenges the authorization to let Hanover Township know that Lower Nazareth Township is willing to pay 1/3, or roughly \$1.5 million plus other costs accrued was moved by Mr. Nagle and seconded by Mr. Kucsan. The motion carried unanimously.
