**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER
NAZARETH, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING
THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS FUNDS FROM THE 2019
FISCAL YEAR**

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a Second Class Township located in Northampton County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code requires all Second Class Townships to adopt an annual budget and to operate financially within those parameters; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2018, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township adopted the annual budget for the 2019 fiscal year projecting revenues in the amount of \$4,481,500 and expenditures in the amount of \$4,481,500; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2019, the total revenues actually received by Lower Nazareth Township were \$4,745,868.51 and the total expenditures actually expended were \$4,397,258.01 and

WHEREAS, this leaves a surplus of \$348,610.50 for the 2019 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code §3202(f) provides the ability to transfer unencumbered funds to other Township accounts.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township authorize the Township Secretary/Treasurer (in compliance with Second Class Township Code §3202(f)) to transfer unencumbered funds from the 2019 fiscal year as follows:

\$140,000.00	- Capital Reserve for Highway Capital Equipment
\$ 25,000.00	- Capital Reserve for equipment for Colonial Regional PD
\$ 65,000.00	- Capital Reserve for equipment for the Hecktown Fire Company
\$ 8,610.50	- Capital Reserve for computer equipment purchases
\$ 85,000.00	- Capital Reserve for Municipal Building Upgrades
\$ 15,000.00	- Capital Reserve for Planning
