Resolution #LNT-16-15

RE: O.R.E. Rentals Land Development

WHEREAS, the Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors are in receipt of a preliminary/final land development plan entitled, "Preliminary/Final Land Development Plans for O.R.E. Rentals Proposed Retail/Rental Store", prepared by Bohler Engineering, of Center Valley, Pennsylvania, consisting of (17) sheets, dated February 20, 2015 and last revised August 26, 2015; and

WHEREAS, under Resolution #LNT-08-15, Lower Nazareth Township approved the subdivision of Tax Parcel #L8-11A-5, lands owned by Charles and Mary Topping, together with the conveyance of 0.826 acres from Tax Parcel L8-11A-3-6 owned by Fairfield Development, to create two conforming lots, one of which is intended for the development of lands for O.R.E Rentals; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the Plan is the development of (1) 8,935 s.f. building and (1) 9,120 s.f. building to be used for the sale and rental of industrial equipment with outdoor storage, located on proposed Tax Parcel #L8-11A-5A, 182 Commerce Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Nazareth Township Zoning Hearing Board granted a variance related to the maximum driveway width as outlined in Zoning Appeal #ZA2015-04 Order and Opinion (Exhibit A);

WHEREAS, a Conditional Use Hearing was held on September 23, 2015 and the Lower Nazareth Board of Supervisors granted approval at their October 14, 2015 meeting (Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, the Lower Nazareth Township Planning Commission recommended approval of the land development plan at its July 20, 2015 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the Final Plan against the provisions of the 2005 Lower Nazareth Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance and has offered comments in his letter dated October 14, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Township Zoning Administrator has reviewed the Final Plan against the provisions of the 2001 Lower Nazareth Township Zoning Ordinance, amended March 23, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors desire to take final action on this plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors approve the Final Plan as referenced above, subject to the following conditions:

1. Provided the comments in the Township Engineer's letter dated October 14, 2015, are adequately addressed. Any reports or documentation requested by the Township Engineer must be provided to both the Township and Township Engineer prior to plan recording.

2. The Applicant must satisfy the requirements of the Conditional Use Opinion and Order as executed by the Board of Supervisors Chairman and Secretary, and any subsequent actions of the Board relative to said Order and Opinion.
3. The applicant is responsible for executing an Improvement Agreement and submitting an acceptable form of security for the public improvements. By acceptance of this resolution, the applicant acknowledges that the Final Plan will not be signed, nor will the Improvement Agreement be approved and executed by the Board of Supervisors until the security has been received and deemed acceptable. The applicant understands that no construction can commence, nor will any permit applications be accepted until such time as all conditions of approval are met and the Final Plan has been recorded.
4. For recording, the applicant shall supply to Lower Nazareth Township:

Sheets C-1 and C-2

- (2) Sets of Mylar reproducible prints;
- (2) Sets of paper prints;

Full Sets

- (4) Sets of paper prints.

All prints shall have original signatures. These copies will be used for distribution to Northampton County, Lehigh Valley Planning Commission, Lower Nazareth Township, and one copy returned to the Applicant. The applicant is welcome to provide additional copies to be signed for their records. Lower Nazareth Township will obtain all plan signatures. Per the Northampton County Uniform Parcel Identifier Ordinance, the applicant is responsible for placement of property addresses on the above plans. Upon satisfaction of all conditions of approval and placement of signatures on the Plans, the Township shall record, within ninety (90) days of said satisfaction, the approved Plan at the Northampton County Recorder of Deeds Office as required by Section 513(a) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10513(a), as amended and Section 520 of the Lower Nazareth Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.


5. The applicant is prohibited from commencing any construction activities on this project until a pre-construction conference is scheduled and conducted in compliance with Section 536 of the Subdivision and Subdivision Ordinance and a formal Notice to Proceed is issued by the Township. Said pre-construction conference shall not occur until Items 1 thru 4 above are completed to the Township's satisfaction.
6. The Applicant understands that any changes to the proposed uses and/or the land development in general are subject to Township review and may require additional review and approval by the Board of Supervisors and/or outside agencies. Under no circumstances, shall any site work nor construction occur that is not depicted on the approved plan nor approved by Lower Nazareth Township and outside agencies.
7. Pursuant to the Conditions of Approval for the Hecktown Road Business Park Subdivision Plan, Phases II and III, no increased traffic from Commerce Park Drive will be permitted until the traffic signal at the Hecktown Road intersection is installed and operational; therefore, Use & Occupancy of this property shall not be permitted until the conditions of approval for that plan are satisfied.

8. All correspondence regarding the plan shall be directed to the Township or if directed to the Engineer, the Township shall be copied.
9. The applicant shall accept these conditions in writing, within five days of receipt of the finalized Board of Supervisors resolution, otherwise the application is denied for failure to comply with the express conditions that are contained in this Resolution.


