A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE GREENWAYS, TRAILS AND RECREATION PROGRAM ON BEHALF OF LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township owns a 14-acre parcel that is currently an undeveloped neighborhood park; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township desires to develop the property as a neighborhood park for the benefit and enjoyment of the community; and

WHEREAS, as part of the development of the neighborhood park, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township desires to create a neighborhood park that will be utilized by people of all ages and abilities; and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the development includes the installation of a 1,700-foot perimeter walking trail and a nature-based playground;

WHEREAS, it is proposed that the playground will have an ADA-access path and the equipment installed shall be ADA-compliant;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County Pennsylvania hereby request a Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program (GTRP) grant of \$100,000.00 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the purpose of installing a perimeter walking trail and a nature-themed playground.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Lori A. Stauffer, Township Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
