A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE NORTHAMPTON/LEHIGH COUNTIES LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT ON BEHALF OF LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AIR PACKS FOR THE HECKTOWN VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a community consisting of approximately 13.59 square miles with a population of 5,674 people; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township recognizes their responsibilities under the Second Class Township Code to provide fire protection services to the constituents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company was formed in 1917 and they have consistently served the Lower Nazareth Township community; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide basic fire protection services for the community, the volunteers of the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company require certain equipment, including air packs, for the protection and safety of the volunteers in the performance of their duties; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County Pennsylvania hereby request a Northampton/Lehigh Counties Local Share Account grant of \$42,920 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the purpose of purchasing air packs for the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Lori A. Stauffer, Township Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
