**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP
MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE
MONROE COUNTY LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT
ON BEHALF OF LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP
FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A 2022
PUMPER/RESCUE TRUCK FOR THE
HECKTOWN VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY**

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a community consisting of approximately eight square miles with a population of 5,674 people; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township recognizes their responsibilities under the Second Class Township Code to provide fire protection services to the constituents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company was formed in 1917 and they have consistently served the Lower Nazareth Township community; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide basic fire protection services for the community, the volunteers of the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company require certain equipment, including different types of trucks, for the adequate protection and preservation of the property in the community; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County Pennsylvania hereby request a Monroe County Local Share Account grant of \$500,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the purpose of purchasing a 2022 pumper/rescue truck for the Hecktown Volunteer Fire Company.


