The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a virtual meeting on Wednesday July 14, 2021. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.

Agenda Approval

Solicitor Asteak requested to add two items to tonight's agenda... (1) Recreational fee waiver request for Fanstastic1948 and (2) Request to commence earth moving for LVTC II. A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Mr. Hoyer to add these items to the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Mr. Hoyer to approve the June 9th meeting minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

Reports (Reports are available to review at the Township Office and on our website.)

Mr. Pennington acknowledged the receipt of the Financial Report for May 2021 and the Hecktown Fire Incident Report for June 2021.

Supervisor's Comments

Mr. Pennington attended the COG meeting on Monday July 12th. The update to the plan continues to move ahead.

Mr. Hoyer attended the EAC meeting on Monday July 12th. The are finalizing the ranking system and will provide a copy to the BOS at their next meeting.

Mr. Hoyer reported that the have receive an application from the Rod and Gun Club and they have started the review process.

Ms. Templeton provided updates to the park projects. Bids were received for the Surrey Glen Walking Trail, LVHN made a donation for the trail and a sign will be erected naming the trail the LVHN Walking Trail. The playground equipment has been ordered and will be delivered in August. Public Works will prepare the site.

The sign for the Newburg Park has been ordered. Public Works has staked out the placement area. Mr. Pennington inquired about the dog fence. Ms. Stauffer indicated the install has started but not completed.

^{***}The Board held an executive session prior to this evening's meeting to discuss legal matters. ***

Ms. Templeton stated that the Memorial Library's Annual Report is available for anyone wanted to review it. She also stated that the library is planning to run their Touch a Truck Event this October.

Mr. Boucher and Mr. Brown had no comments.

Subdivision & Land Development

Fantastic 1948 Recreation Fee Waiver Request – Solicitor Asteak indicated he was in receipt of a letter from Attorney Curcio requesting relief from recreation fees for her client's development on Country Club Road. Mr. Pennington was not in favor of granting the request because while the development is for recreation it is still a private business. A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Mr. Boucher to deny the request. The motion caried unanimously.

<u>LVTC II Earth Movement Request</u> – Solicitor Asteak indicated he was in receipt of a letter from Attorney Durso requesting her client be permitted to begin site work prior to plan recording. A motion was moved by Ms. Templeton and was seconded by Mr. Hoyer to approve site work prior to plan recording. The motion caried unanimously.

Solicitor's Report

There were no comments under Solicitor's Report.

Engineer's Report

Newburg Park Restroom – Payment Approval – Mr. Kortze reviewed his July 12th letter recommending payment of \$37,750.45 to Kobalt Construction for payments 8, #9, and #10. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Ms. Templeton to approve payment as recommended. The motion carried unanimously.

Newburg Park – Electric Update – Mr. Kortze provided an update on the electric service the park. Met-Ed has indicated they can provide 2500-amp service which Mr. Kortze believes will be sufficient for the site. Met-Ed is working on a field design and the engineer will determine the final price. There is no timeline.

Manager's Report

Surrey Glen Walking Path Bid Award – Mr. Kortze's July 12th letter recommended the project be awarded to Bruce George Paving & Excavating at a cost of \$109,106.70. A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Ms. Templeton to award to the project as recommended. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>RAE Homes – Masonry Mailbox Agreement</u> - A motion was moved by Mr. Boucher and was seconded by Mr. Brown to approve the agreement. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Township E-Cycling Event</u> – Ms. Stauffer stated the Township will be holding an e-cycling event on Wednesday October 6th from 3pm to 6pm at our Recycling Facility at 4600 Newburg Road. The reason for a mid-week event is that the recycling companies are booked weekends into 2022.

Payment of the Bills

A motion was moved by Mr. Brown and was seconded by Mr. Hoyer to approve payment of the bills dated July 14th. The motion carried unanimously.

Courtesy of the Floor

Jeff Shepherd indicated that the HOA at Trio Fields has hired an engineer to produce a report of issues for phases 1-6A and that the report was forwarded to Kay Builders and Lower Nazareth. Ms. Stauffer stated that the report was not forwarded to the Township Engineer because the HOA will need to provide escrow funds to cover the review fees. That information was provided to the attorney that previously reached out to Ms. Seese.

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Mr. Shepherd also comments that the library is filing for numerous grants and is looking for feedback from municipalities on the "expansion" of the library. He will follow up with Ms. Stauffer.

Peter Collins. 4255 Beech Drive, read an email he sent to the HOA on behalf of the residents in the 4200 and 4300 block of Beech Drive regarding Kay Builder's lack of mowing open spaces which is leading to wildlife issues on properties. He requested feedback from the Bos on whether builders are exempt from maintaining open space areas and if any deals were made with Kay Builders. Mr. Collins was looking for clarification on Kay Builder's responsibilities.
