A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER NAZARETH, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA TO ENTER INTO AN INTERMUNICIPAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF TATAMY, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a Second Class Township in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania governed by the Second Class Township Code and the laws of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, Tatamy Borough is a Borough in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania governed by the Pennsylvania Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, Tatamy Borough has requested to enter into an intermunicipal cooperation agreement for the purpose of allowing their residents access to the Lower Nazareth Township recycling center to dispose of residential yard waste; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township have agreed to enter into an intermunicipal cooperation agreement at a public meeting on October 13, 2021; and

WHEREAS, each Municipality is a "local government" under the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa. C.S.A. Section 2301, et. seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa. C.S.A. Section 2301, et. seq., two or more local governments can jointly cooperate with one another in the performance of respective governmental functions, powers and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township and the Borough Council of Tatamy Borough are desirous of memorializing that their respective municipalities are willing to undertake the duties and responsibilities for the projects as outlined in the attached Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021, the Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors adopts this resolution and resolves to enter into an intermunicipal cooperation agreement with the Borough of Tatamy for the purpose of allowing Tatamy residents access to the Lower Nazareth Township recycling facility for the disposal of residential yard waste.

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the intermunicipal cooperation agreement attached to this resolution on behalf of Lower Nazareth Township.

**DULY ADOPTED** on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021 at a duly advertised public meeting and by a majority of the entire Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township.

## **Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement**

THIS AGREEMEN	T, made and entered into this6 day of
December	, 2021, by and between the Township of Lower Nazareth, a
Second Class Township and	political subdivision of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with
offices at 623 Municipal Driv	ve, Nazareth, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter
referred to as "Lower Nazare	th"; and, the Borough of Tatamy, a Borough and political
subdivision of the Commonv	vealth of Pennsylvania with offices at 432 Broad Street, PO Box
218, Tatamy, Northampton C	County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Tatamy."
WHEREAS, the Mun	nicipalities are both members of the Nazareth Area Council of
Governments; and	
WHEREAS, Lower 1	Nazareth and Tatamy through their respective and duly elected
officials, have determined that	t it is
WHEREAS, the Second	ond Class Code authorizes such agreements amongst municipalities
for the purpose of performing	governmental powers, duties and functions (53 P.S. Sec. 66507);
and	
WHEREAS, the Boro	ough Code authorizes such agreements amongst municipalities for
the purpose of performing go	vernmental powers, duties and functions.

WHEREAS, each Municipality is a "local government" under the Intergovernmental

Cooperation Act, 53, Pa. C.S.A. Section 2301 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa. C.S.A. Section 2301, et. seq., two or more local governments can jointly cooperate with one another in the performance of respective governmental functions, powers and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Tatamy has requested access to the Lower Nazareth recycling center so the residents of Tatamy can dispose of their residential yard waste; and

WHEREAS, the Municipalities are desirous of memorializing that their respective municipalities are willing to undertake the duties and responsibilities for the projects as outlined in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good, valuable, mutual, and sufficient consideration, and intending to be legally bound hereby, and pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania Second Class Code, Pennsylvania Borough Code, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act and applicable Pennsylvania law, it is hereby agreed as follows:

- (1) LOWER NAZARETH and TATAMY hereby enter into a cooperative effort, where LOWER NAZARETH shall permit residents of TATAMY to utilize the LOWER NAZARETH recycling facility located at 4600 Newburg Road, Nazareth, Pennsylvania 18064.
- (2) **LOWER NAZARETH** recycling facility is open from March 1<sup>st</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup> each year. The days and times of operation are Monday and Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and the first and third Saturday every month from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- (3) **LOWER NAZARETH** recycling facility is also open the first week in January from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for the purpose of accepting Christmas trees.
- (4) **TATAMY** shall be responsible for issuing permits to their residents, who shall be required to present the permit at the time of drop off at the recycling facility.

- (5) TATAMY shall be responsible for the collection of permits fees, which shall be remitted to LOWER NAZARETH on a quarterly basis with a report of permits issued. The cost of the permit shall be established by the elected officials of LOWER NAZARETH at their annual reorganization meeting.
- (6) **LOWER NAZARETH** shall be responsible for the disposal of the residential yard waste that enters its recycling facility.
- (7) Residents of **TATAMY** shall adhere to the rules and regulations established for the drop-off of residential yard waste.
- (8) This Agreement shall continue to be effective until terminated upon thirty (30) days advance written notice by any Municipality to the other Municipalities, at which time all rights and obligations arising hereunder shall cease.
- (9) A Resolution authorizing this Agreement has been duly adopted by the governing bodies of the Municipalities.
- (10) This Agreement represents the final and entire agreement between the parties hereto. The recitals set forth in the beginning of this Agreement are incorporated in and made a part of this Agreement. No change or modification of this Agreement shall be valid unless the same is in writing and signed by the parties hereto.
- (11) The parties hereto acknowledge that this Agreement contains the implied covenant of good faith and fair dealings in the performance under this Agreement. The parties hereto covenant, warrant, and represent to each other good faith, complete cooperation, due diligence, and honesty in fact in the performance of all obligations of the parties pursuant t this Agreement. All promises and covenants are mutual and dependent.

- (12) The parties hereto shall execute and deliver all documents, provide all information and take or forbear from all such action(s) as may be necessary or appropriate to achieve the purposes of this Agreement.
- (13) This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without regard to its laws regarding conflict of laws.

  Jurisdiction and venue for any legal proceedings pursuant to this Agreement shall be with the Court of Common Pleas of Northampton County, Pennsylvania.
- party, at any time, to require performance by the other of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect or impair the right of that party to enforce the same at a subsequent time. The waiver, by any party, of any breach of any provision of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of any succeeding breach of such provision or a waiver of the provision itself. Unless stated otherwise, all rights and remedies contained in this Agreement are cumulative and are in addition to any other rights or remedies at law or in equity.
- (15) All notices, requests, demands, consents, approvals or communications required or permitted to be given under any provision of this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed given upon either personal delivery or the mailing thereof by certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed to each party at the addresses recited above.
