RESOLUTION NO. LINT-37-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER NAZARETH, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA REQUESTING NAZARETH BOROUGH MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT PUBLIC SANITARY SEWERS WITHIN GEORGETOWN MANOR AND FOR THE DEDICATION OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN MONEY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PUBLIC SEWER

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a Second Class Township in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania governed by the Second Class Township Code and the laws of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the elected officials of a local government body to ensure the health, safety and welfare of its constituents, including, but not limited to, the proper sanitary disposal of sewage waste; and

WHEREAS, Article XXV of the Second Class Township Code (Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69) as amended, authorizes the municipal governing body to make provisions for the establishment and the construction of sanitary sewers; and

WHEREAS, Georgetown Manor is a housing development that was constructed in Lower Nazareth Township in the 1970s and it was originally served by on-lot septic systems; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has received complaints from numerous residents of the development regarding significant failures of the on-lot septic systems and requests for the installation of public sewers; and

WHEREAS, the majority of lots in Georgetown Manor consist of ½ acre, which is not a lot size that is usually practical for the repair and replacement of an on-lot septic system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has engaged the services of William Dingman, P.E. of Gilmore & Associates to conduct an Act 537 plan to prepare for the installation of public sanitary sewer within Georgetown Manor; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has also participated in discussion with Nazareth Municipal Sewer Authority to bring public sewer to the Georgetown Manor development; and

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township was allocated a total of \$689,839.76 from the federal American Rescue Plan funding; and

WHEREAS, the investment in public sewers is an acceptable use of the American Rescue Plan funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED on this 8th day of December, 2021, the Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors adopts this resolution and resolves the following:

- (1) Upon completion of the requisite Act 537 planning module, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township requests the Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority to provide for the construction of public sanitary sewers within the Georgetown Manor development, which for the purposes of this project includes 64 properties located on Brandywine Road, Concord Road, Lexington Road, King George Drive and James Drive in the service area of the Nazareth Municipal Sewer Authority with the properties highlighted on the attached "Exhibit A"; and
- (2) Upon installation of the public sanitary sewer system, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township will require all property owners within the Georgetown Manor Sewer District to hook up to the public sewer within a time period as prescribed by the Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority and the ordinances of Lower Nazareth Township.
- The Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township shall further pledge up to Three Hundred Eight-Four Thousand (\$384,000) Dollars from the American Rescue Plan funding towards the construction costs and subsequently, the Nazareth Borough Municipal Authority shall credit each property owner within the defined sewer district for the costs associated with the tap-in and connection fees to the property owners for the Georgetown Manor Sewer District. This credit shall be equal to \$6,000 per property.

DULY ADOPTED on this 8th day of December, 2021 at a duly advertised public meeting and by a majority of the entire Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township.
