LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS** MINUTES March 22, 2023

The Lower Nazareth Township Board of Supervisors held a hybrid meeting on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, Chairman James Pennington called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM.

Agenda Amendment and Approval

Ms. Stauffer request that Northampton Farms LLC Requests for Continuance be added under Subdivision and Land Development. Mr. Hoyer made a motion to approve the amended agenda. Mr. Brown seconded. Motion passed.

Conditional Use Hearing - CU2023-04 Easton Eastgate LLC - Ms. Stauffer noted that the applicant requested a continuance until the April 26th meeting. Solicitor Asteak noted he will not be available that night therefore the hearing date will be determined later. Ms. Templeton made a motion to approve the request for continuance. Mr. Hoyer seconded. Motion passed.

Approval of Minutes

The meeting minutes of March 8, 2023 were submitted for review and approval. Mr. Boucher made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Ms. Templeton seconded. Motion passed.

Reports

The Hecktown Fire Incident Report for February 2023 was presented. The Board thanks the volunteers.

Supervisor's Comments

Open Space Preservation – Mr. Hoyer noted that their March meeting was cancelled.

<u>Parks & Recreation</u> - Ms. Templeton provided updates on Township Parks and Events planned.

Newburg Park:

Fencing (Detention Basin) – Both quotes have been provided. The cost of the chain link fence would be \$45,261 and the cost of the split fence with wire mesh would be \$27,932. The Recreation Committee is recommending split rail fencing with wire mesh. Mr. Boucher made a motion to approve the purchase of split rail fencing. Mr. Brown seconded. Motion passed.

Subdivision and Land Development

Northampton Farms LLC: Requests for Continuance – Ms. Stauffer noted that we have received a request for continuance for the May 10th and May 11th hearing dates. Mr. Hoyer inquired if they provided suggested dates but was not in favor of the continuance. There was no motion to extend.

Solicitor's Report

Notaro Real Estate Tax Bills – Ms. Stauffer noted that Mrs. Notaro received her 2023 County and Township tax bills for her properties on Nazareth Pike and Newburg Road. Ms. Stauffer discussed how the bills should be apportioned between Lower Nazareth and Mrs. Notaro. The recommendation was to pay 50% of the building portion of the Nazareth Pike parcel and 75% of the building portion for the Newburg parcel. The total for both the County and Township tax bills would be \$1,399.57. Mr. Hoyer made a motion to pay our apportioned share of the tax bill. Ms. Templeton seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Keystone Foods Phase II – Improvements Agreement</u> – Ms. Stauffer noted that we have a letter of credit, and the agreement has been executed by the applicant. Mr. Hoyer made a motion for the Township to execute the improvements agreement. Ms. Templeton seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Koch 33- Improvements Agreement</u> – Ms. Stauffer noted that we have a letter of credit, and the agreement has been executed by the applicant. Mr. Hoyer made a motion for the Township to execute the improvements agreement. Ms. Templeton seconded. Motion passed.

Engineer's Report

Newburg Park Waterline – Mr. Kortze reported that the water authority with me mobilizing next week and will coordinate with Public Works. The work should take a few weeks.

Manager's Report

Newburg Intersection – Notaro & Clemis Demolition – Mr. Kortze's review letter provides the two quotes received: Beatty Contractors at \$255,000 and Ben Washington at \$368,000. Ms. Stauffer noted that the timeline to complete the work is 60-90 days. The worst will be getting the utilities disconnected. The invoice will be paid out of the Traffic Impact Fund. Mr. Brown made a motion to award the contract to Beatty Contractors. Mr. Boucher seconded. Motion passed.

Payment of the Bills

Ms. Templeton made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Mr. Boucher seconded. Motion passed.

Courtesy of Floor

Mr. Brown welcomed Troop #76 to the meeting. He noted we are the beneficiary of several Eagle Scout Projects. He thanked them for coming.
