APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

SUBDIVISION/LAND DEVELOPMENT

Koch 33 Collision Center Expansion – Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan

Present for the Application: Holly Evans, P.E., Evans Engineering

Holly Evans and Keith Lawler reviewed his comment letter. The requested waivers were discussed. The Planning Commission was concerned about the change of parking for cars to parking for employees. Would there be enough parking? Holly stated it is simply a demonstration that they can comply with the Zoning Ordinance requirements. Lori Seese reviewed her comment letter.

The motion to recommend approval of the Koch 33 Collision Center Expansion Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan along with the requested waivers provided the comments in the letters from Keith Lawler and Lori Seese are satisfactorily addressed was moved by Hugh Harris and seconded by Bert Smalley. The motion passed unanimously.

Stone Briar II - Preliminary/Final Major Subdivision Plan

Present for the Application: Lew Rauch, Lehigh Engineering

Lew Rauch noted they were not looking for formal action. They know that they must get a zoning change. Applicant Ron Delserro wanted the plan to get back before the Planning

Commission. They are working with the Board of Supervisors regarding land preservation for a portion of the surround properties. They also have outside agency approvals they need to obtain. Discussion about the agricultural security/easement status of adjoining parcels. The Planning Commission had no other concerns with the plan. When the plan comes back before the Planning Commission, the formality of a motion should be the only thing required.
