The property locations are 523 Nazareth Pike, Nazareth, PA, 18064, and 578 Daniels Road, Nazareth, PA, 18064, specifically Tax Map Parcel #K7-20-11 and K7-20-10. The properties are zoned Light Industrial Campus (LI).
