A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE MONROE COUNTY LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT ON BEHALF OF LOWER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDING FOR A 2025 FORD INCEPTOR AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE COLONIAL REGIONAL POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a community consisting of approximately thirteen square miles with a population of 6,922 people; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township recognizes their responsibilities under the Second Class Township Code to provide police protection to the constituents of the Township in order to protect their health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Colonial Regional Police Department was established by an intergovernmental agreement in 1995 and they have consistently served the Townships of Lower Nazareth and Hanover by providing police services; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide basic police protection services for the community, the officers of the Colonial Regional Police Department require certain equipment, including vehicles for transportation purposes, which promotes the protection and safety of the officers in the performance of their duties; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County Pennsylvania hereby requests a Monroe County Local Share Account grant of \$89,673.83 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the purpose of purchasing a 2025 Ford Inceptor with equipment for Colonial Regional Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Lori A. Stauffer, Township Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
