WHEREAS, Lower Nazareth Township is a community consisting of approximately eight square miles with a population of 6,922 people; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Nazareth Township recognizes their responsibilities under the Second Class Township Code to provide the constituents of the Township in order to protect their health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower Nazareth has established a municipal building that is the central operations of township operations and services; and

WHEREAS, the municipal building is exhibiting signs of wear and in need of improvements that will allow the Board of Supervisors to continue providing a safe and adequate municipal building for the continuity of operations and services to the public.

BE IT RESOLVED, that Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County Pennsylvania hereby requests a Statewide Local Share Account grant of \$278,796.92 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the purpose of making municipal building improvements to the Lower Nazareth Township municipal building located at 623 Municipal Drive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Lori A. Stauffer, Township Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Lower Nazareth Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
