Dear Parents (Guardians) and Campers:

Welcome to the Lower Nazareth Township Summer Park Program. The staff has put a great deal of time and effort into planning another exciting and enjoyable summer. For the program to be a success we have implemented the policies listed below. Please thoroughly review the guidelines and sign on the back if you agree with the terms.

PARKING & DROP OFF PROCEDURE

- For everyone's safety please park your car in the parking lot when dropping off/retrieving your campers. You would then have to walk the campers over the pavilion to sign them in.
- Campers must sign-in with the leaders upon arrival. **Campers may not be dropped off prior to 9:00 am and should arrive NO LATER THAN 9:30 AM so that the groups can leave the pavilion to start enjoying the planned activities.** Campers will receive a wristband to wear while participating in the program.
- Every camper must be retrieved by a parent/guardian or authorized person. Campers are not permitted to leave the park on their own. Please make sure you have listed the individuals that will be your "authorized person" who will be dropping off or picking up your campers on the registration form.
- Campers are to be signed out with their leaders and return the wristband each day. **Campers need to be picked up promptly at the end of each session. Late pick-ups will not be tolerated. After ONE late pick-up, the campers not picked up on time may be dropped from the program with NO REFUND.**

PARTICIPANT & PARENTAL BEHAVIOR

For us to operate an efficient and organized program, it is necessary for the staff to maintain control of the campers during our activities. It is your responsibility to discuss with your children his/her behavior while attending the program.

- Disruptive, abusive behavior, foul language, and rude behavior by campers and/or parents towards the Program Director, Program Leaders, Township Staff, Program Visitors, other Splash Park/Newburg Park attendees will not be tolerated.
- No cell phones or electronic devices. Parents can get a message to campers through the Park Coordinator.
- Do not climb trees. Do not throw sticks, stones, or dirt.
- Keep the park clean – Pick up your trash.
- No fighting, bullying or threatening words – If you have a problem, walk away and tell a Program Leader.
- Disciplinary action will be given when applicable. There is a three (3) strike policy – (1st offense) verbal, (2nd offense) written and parent/guardian spoken to, and (3rd offense) suspension. Fourth offense, camper will be terminated from the program without a refund.

HELPFUL TIPS TO ENSURE HEALTH & SAFETY

- Campers should bring a water bottle with their name on it.
- **Please pack a snack (NUT FREE!) EVERY DAY along with a WATER BOTTLE.** Numerous



children participating in our program have food allergies. Depending on campers allergies, we may be adding to the “DO NOT BRING SNACK LIST”. **Please check the ingredients list on all food labels to be sure!**

- Please label your camper’s belongings with first & last name.
- **PLEASE APPLY SUNSCREEN PRIOR TO COMING TO PARK.**
- **Campers must wear appropriate bathing suit that provides adequate coverage and bring a towel every day. Campers must not expose their genital area. Female Campers must not expose their chest area.**
- Campers should wear sneakers (no sandals or flip-flops). Campers are allowed to wear croc footwear as long as they have at least a strap over the heel.

WEATHER CANCELLATIONS

Since we do not have a building at the Newburg Park for the campers to participate in indoor activities during inclement weather, camp may be cancelled more than in the past. Feel free to keep your campers home on any day with inclement weather.

- In the event of inclement weather with an unfavorable forecast prior to 9:00 am, the program will be cancelled. **This decision will be made approximately (1) one hour prior to the scheduled start time and will be based upon current weather conditions, facility conditions, and weather forecasts.**
- If we experience bad weather between 9:00 am and 12:00 pm, the children will be moved to the pavilion. Obviously, if the weather conditions are expected to get worse, we will cancel park and encourage parent/guardian or authorized person to retrieve the campers as soon as possible.
- In both situations we will send out a mass text message to parents/guardians. **You will need to notify your authorized person to pick up or drop off your children for that given day of cancellation.**
